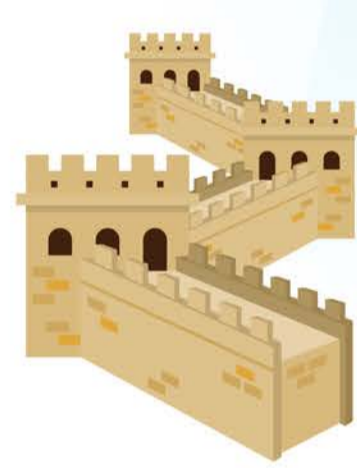
Online Chinese Winter Camp
